Situation

Extended Stay Hotels operates throughout the United States and Canada under five brand names. It has more than 10,000 employees and 2,200 PCs, one fourth of which are scheduled to be replaced each year. The company wanted to streamline hardware refreshes and administration and enhance IT security at all of its properties.

Solution

The hotel group enrolled in a Microsoft Enterprise Agreement in 2008 to cover desktop productivity applications and client access licenses (CALs) for core server products. That agreement also offered Microsoft Software Assurance benefits, including E-Learning, training, support, and the Home Use Program. The company upgraded the agreement in 2010 to include several enterprise components such as Active Directory Rights Management Services, Microsoft Forefront Online Protection for Exchange, and the Microsoft System Center Client Management suite. It also added the Enrollment for Application Platform (EAP) option that provides a CAL for Microsoft SQL Server 2008 R2.

Benefits

By enrolling in a Microsoft Enterprise Agreement, Extended Stay Hotels has:

- **Saved on software acquisition.** By upgrading its Enterprise Agreement and adding the EAP option, Extended Stay Hotels has reduced the licensing cost per desktop while ensuring that all users have the latest software they need to be productive.
